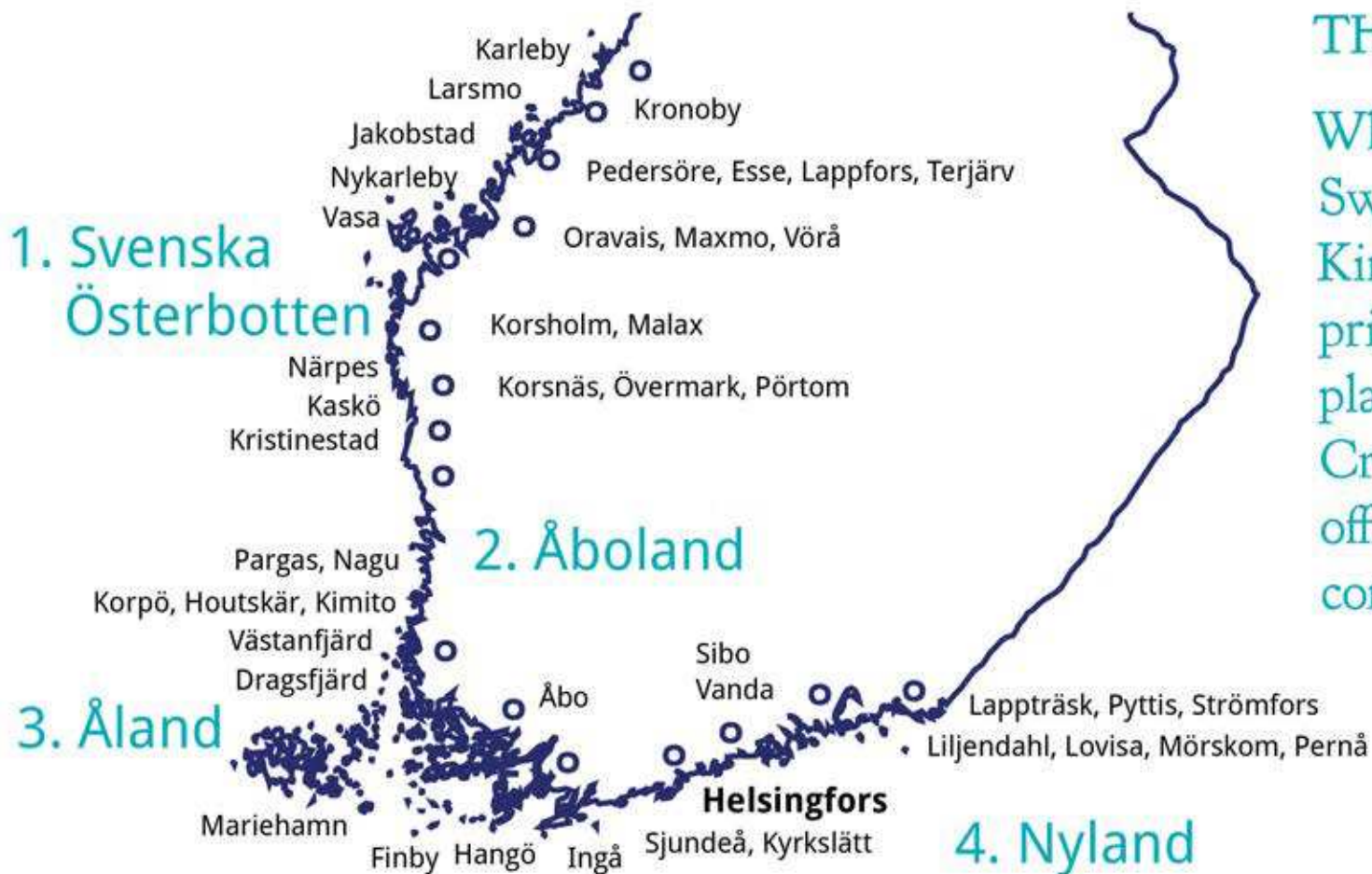

When Finland was part of Sweden's kingdom, the King's governors, soldiers, priests and laborers were placed as far inland as the Crown could control. All official communication was conducted in Swedish.

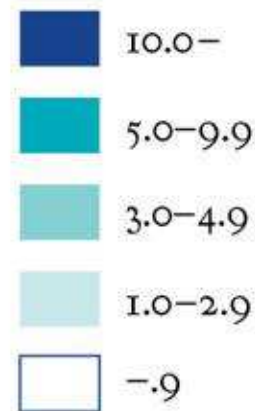
WHERE ARE THE EMIGRANTS FROM?



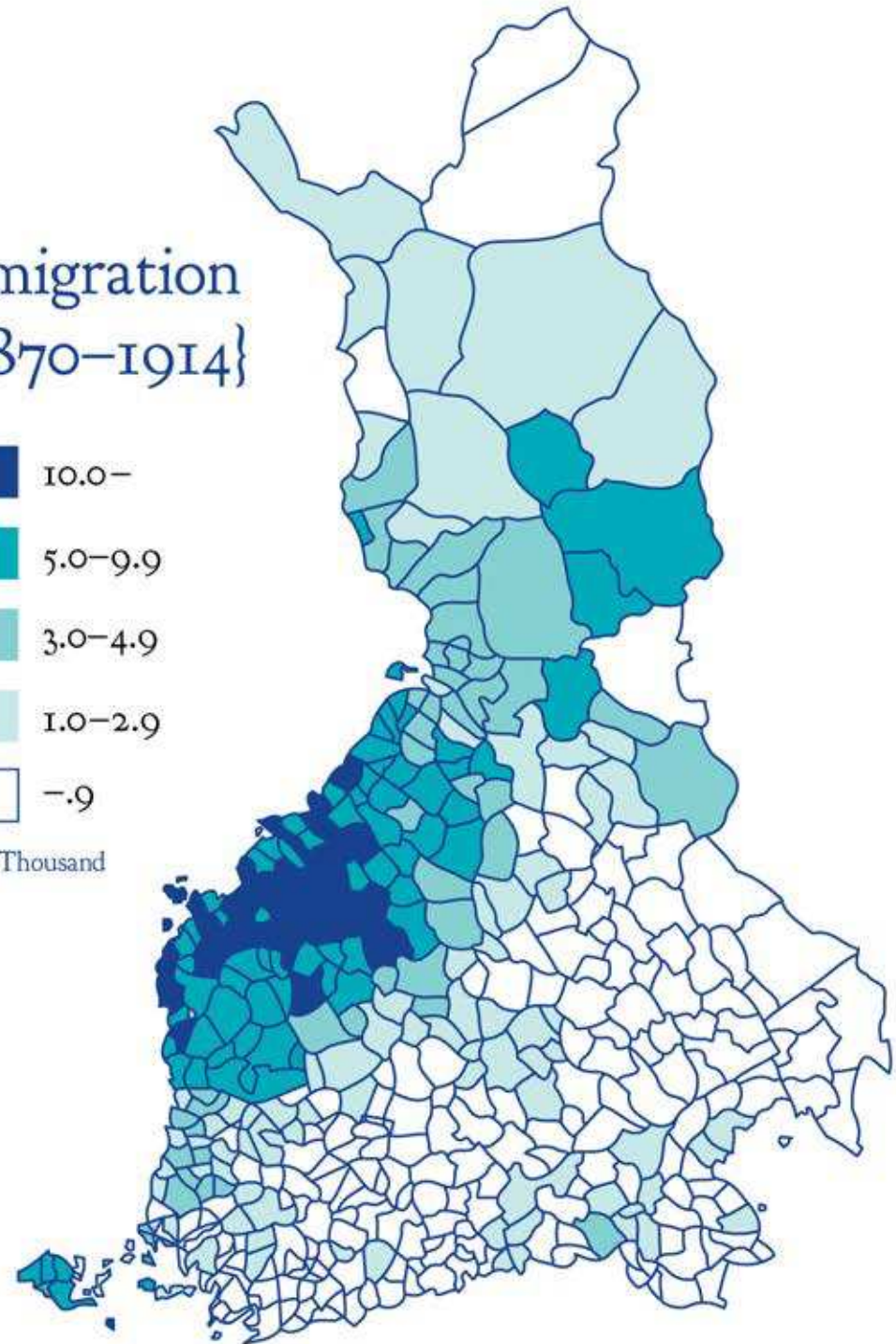
The Swedish-speaking population was about 12% of Finland's total population. But 26% of her emigrants spoke Swedish. About 100,000 left Finland looking for new lives.

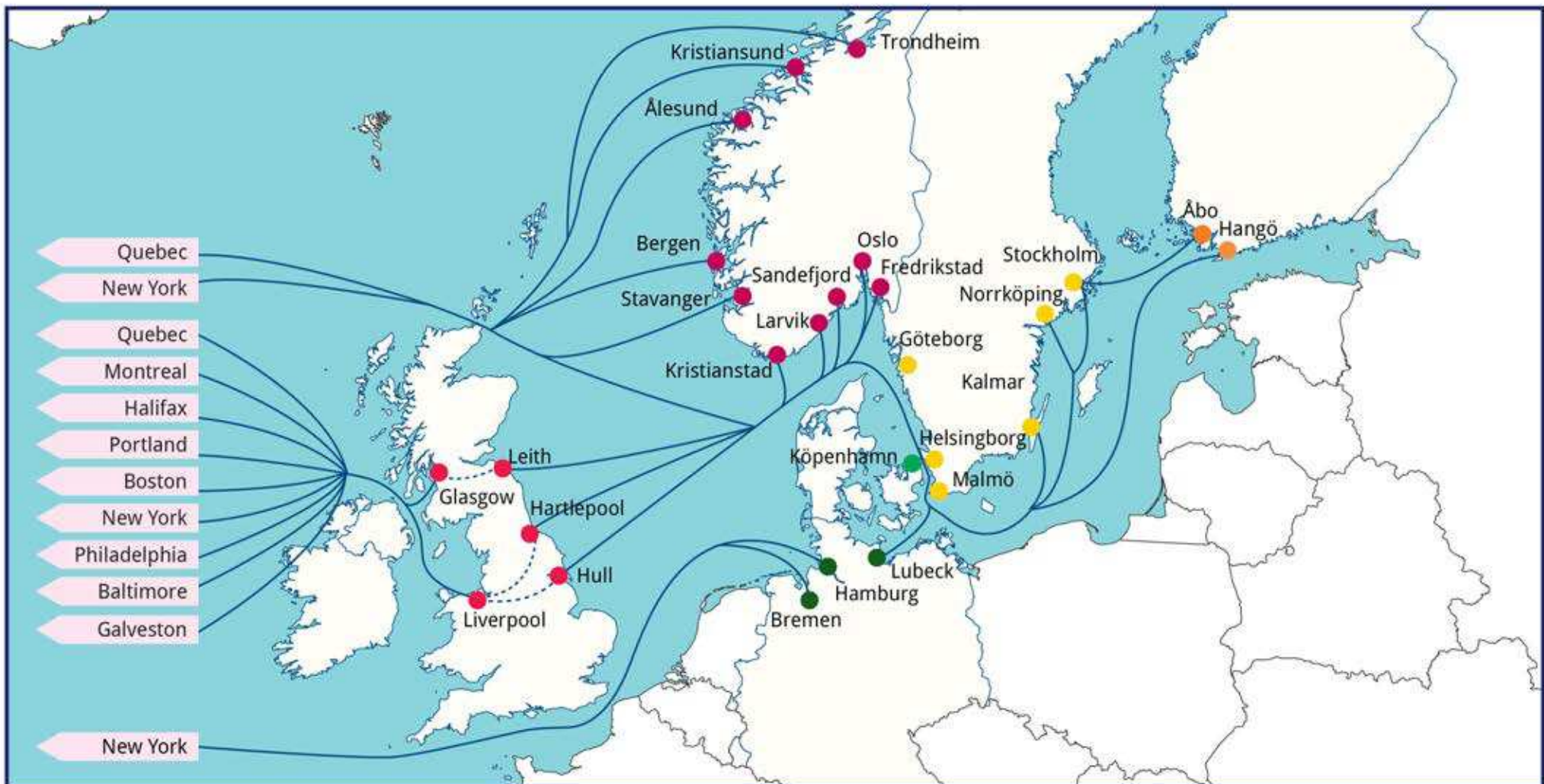

Can you find my great grandmother, Ida Johanna Erickson? She was born in 1894 in Finland, and lived in Duluth, Minnesota...

YOUR ANCESTOR KEPT HER BIRTH NAME, UNTIL SHE MARRIED...

“Mrs. Albert Erickson (Ida Pelander), Nedervetil,” is listed in the Memory Book for the temperance lodge in West Duluth MN. Here we can also discover that Peterson was BONDE,

Engel was ENGELQVIST, Johnson was GÄSTGIVARS, among others. This is very helpful when searching church books in Finland!

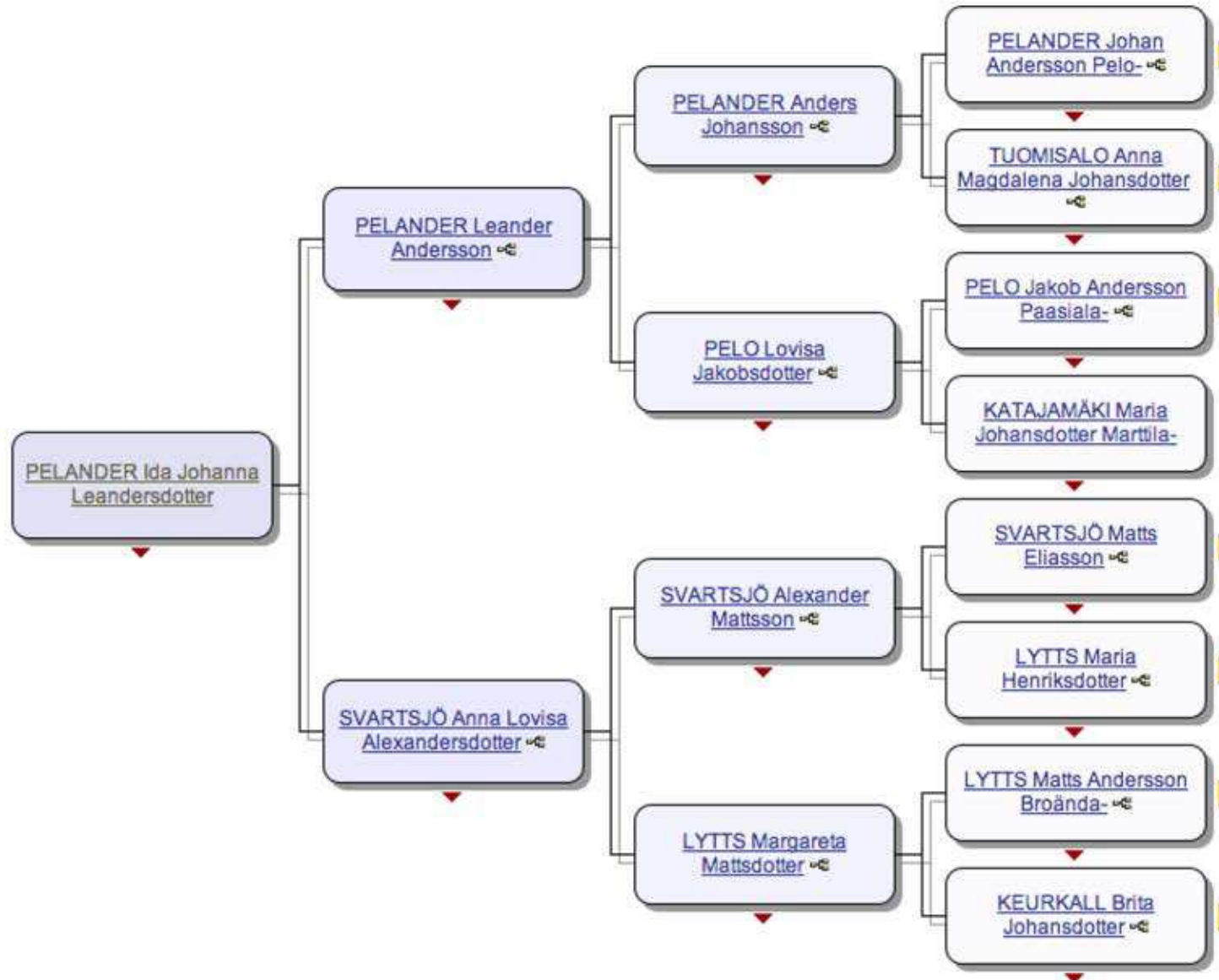

My grandfather said he and all my great aunts and uncles spoke Swedish when they started school. And then he said their parents came from Finland!! Help please!! His name was Henry Gustafson, and lived in Issaquah WA. He died in 2000 at 84 years. My great grandparents lived in Duluth, MN and were named Emil and Katrina Gustafson.

First, I checked DEE. Nope. They're not there. So this will be more difficult. What were their birth dates, and then their birth parishes?



Federal Census records can help. I'll go to 1920 for Duluth MN. Henry will be about 4. His name in the list of persons in the household will help identify the family. {SFHS subscribes to Ancestry's Global Version.}

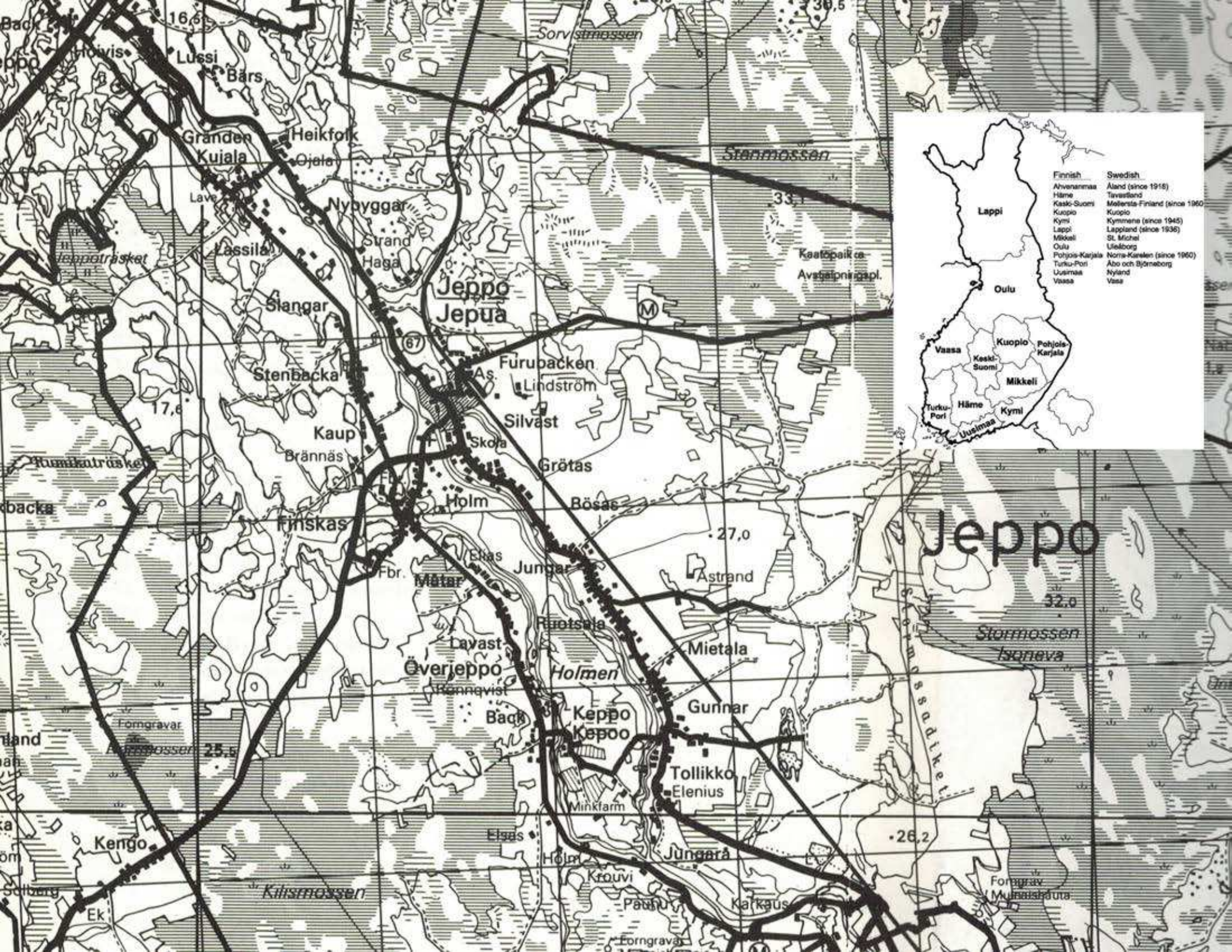

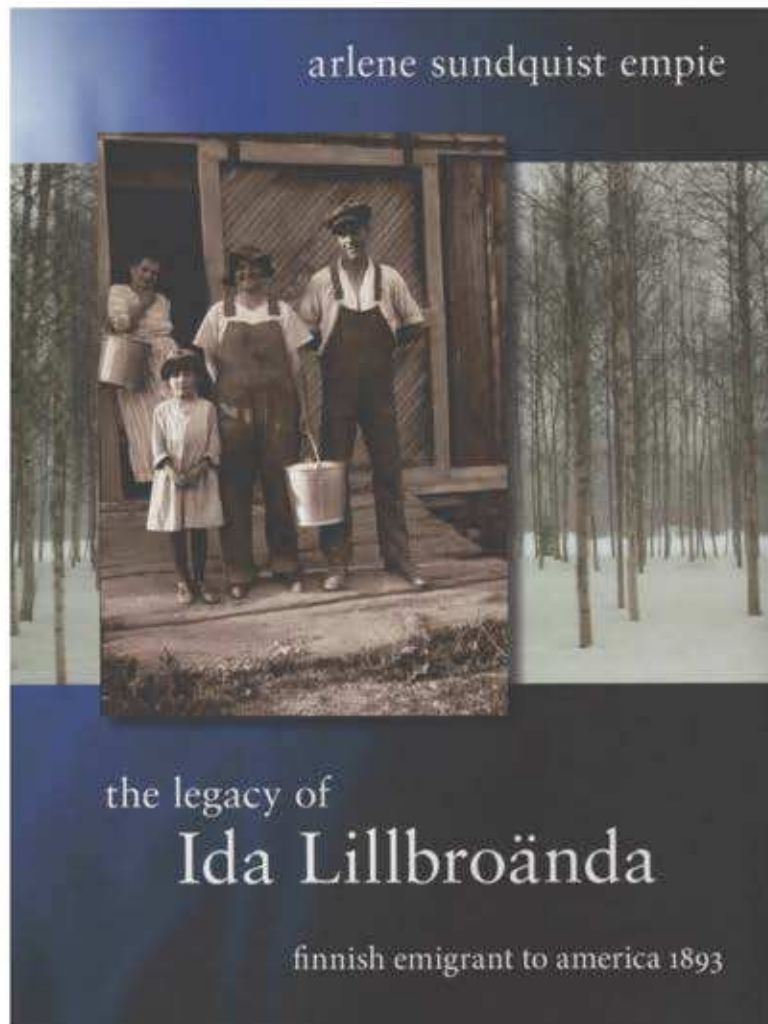
